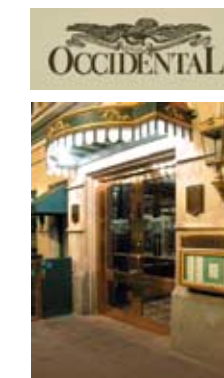

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The purpose of this conference is to update pediatric radiologists regarding state-of-the-art techniques in pediatric imaging, as well as in the diagnostic imaging and the surgical management of cloacal exstrophy. Formal lectures, discussion sessions, and case presentations will allow participants to share experiences in solving difficult diagnostic problems. We hope to provide a forum for pediatric radiologists to network.

TARGET AUDIENCE

This conference is designed for pediatric radiologists, pediatric radiology fellows, and radiology residents.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

After completing this course, participants should be able to describe and discuss:

- scintigraphic techniques for evaluating and interpreting various pediatric bone diseases
- multimodality imaging techniques for evaluating pediatric brain tumors
- the imaging characteristics of cloacal exstrophy, and the role the radiologist plays in assisting in the surgical management of this complex condition
