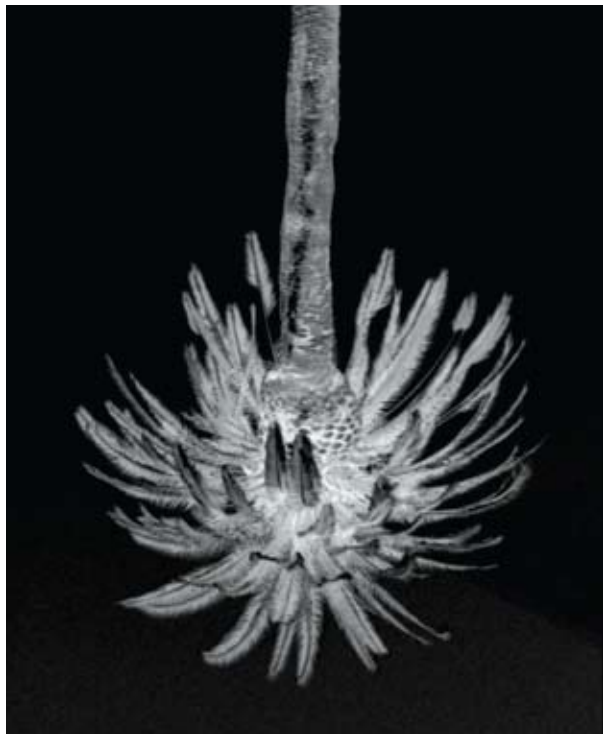

MEETING DESCRIPTION

This three day meeting brings together leading faculty radiologists from major children's hospitals in the US to address important and practical topics in pediatric imaging including: musculoskeletal MRI, abdominal MRI including MR enterography, neuroimaging including intra-operative MRI from the neurosurgeon's perspective, child abuse, and PET/CT. Highlights will include state-of-the-art imaging techniques for diagnosis of pediatric diseases, controversies in pediatric imaging, and utilization of noninvasive or minimally invasive imaging in children.

Host faculty radiologists from Puerto Rico will actively participate in presentations. Formal lectures, discussion sessions, and case presentations will allow participants to share experiences in solving difficult diagnostic problems.

This combined presentation format will foster discussion and promote interaction between faculty and attendees. There will be time allotted for abstract and interesting case presentations. Computer-assisted exhibits will be available throughout the meeting at private viewing stations. The meeting will be conducted in a friendly and relaxed atmosphere with plenty of time for comments and questions. We hope to provide a forum for pediatric radiologists to network.



OBJECTIVES

At the completion of this activity, the participant will be better able to:

- Recognize shoulder anatomy on MRI and imaging findings in common derangements.
- Analyze the patterns of normal and abnormal marrow patterns in children on MRI scans.
- Distinguish the varied appearance of the spectrum of vascular malformations on MRI scans in pediatric patients.
- Explain MRI evaluation of the pediatric liver, and determine imaging patterns and characteristic imaging features in specific entities.
- Review pertinent MR imaging sequences in evaluation of bowel, including patterns of enhancement specific to acute and chronic disease.
- Describe the normal distribution of FDG in the pediatric patient and applications of pediatric FDG PET/CT.
- Identify and review characteristic imaging features of child abuse and differentiate from other entities such as vitamin D deficiency.
- Understand practical applications of intra-operative MRI from the neurosurgeon's perspective.
- Recognize patterns of white matter injuries and diseases of the brain on MRI scans in the pediatric patient.
- Discuss individual case examples via a case-based approach (multiple sessions).

ACCREDITATION

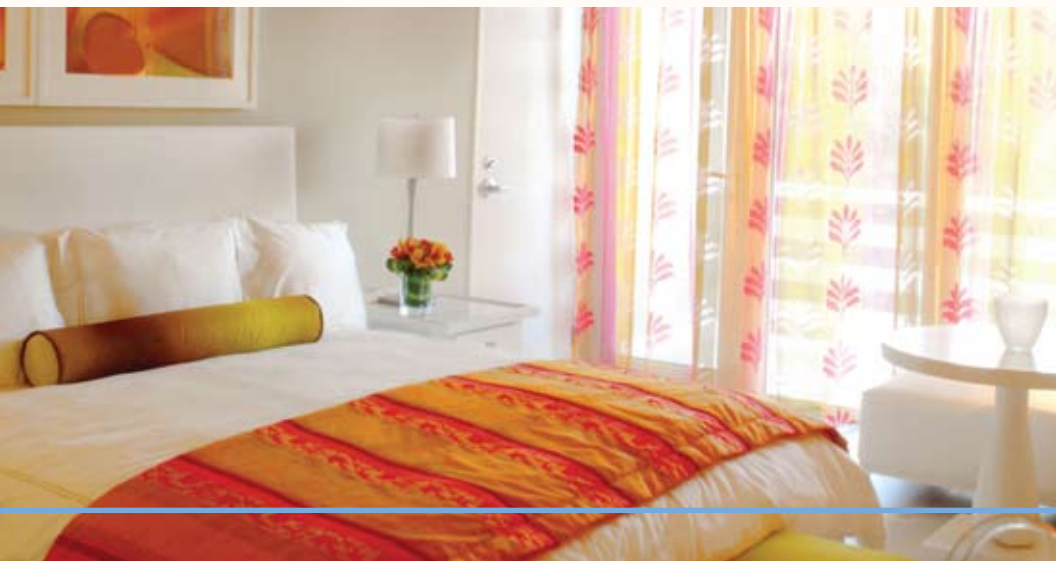
